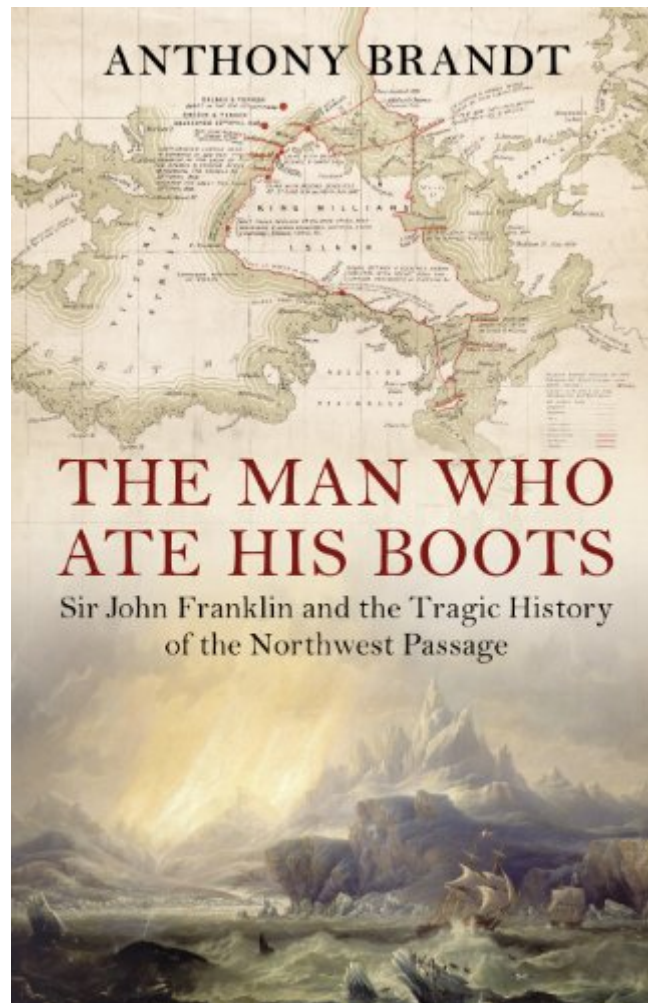


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The Man Who Ate His Boots: Sir John Franklin And The Tragic History Of The Northwest Passage



Synopsis
